THE MISSION OF MOJA

The MOJA Arts Festival: a Celebration of African-American and Caribbean Art, is the City of Charleston's multi-disciplinary festival which celebrates the rich heritage of African and Caribbean cultures. MOJA, a Swahili word meaning "One", is the appropriate name for this celebration of harmony amongst people. Most importantly, the MOJA Arts Festival highlights the many African-American and Caribbean contributions to western and world cultures. Offering theatre, dance, music, visual arts, films and lectures, the MOJA Arts Festival is produced and directed by the City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs and the all-volunteer MOJA Arts Festival Planning Committee.

WHO MAY APPLY

The 26th Annual MOJA Arts Festival Juried Art Exhibition is open to all artists residing in Florida, Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Work will be juried by JPEG formatted CDs and should reflect the mission of the MOJA Arts Festival.

EXHIBITION JUROR

AWARDS

Artwork for the exhibition will be selected by the juror from JPEG formatted CDs submitted by the artists. Cash award winners will also be selected by the juror prior to opening night; all decisions of the juror are final.

Mayor's Purchase Award \$1,250
(artwork purchased for the Mayor's art collection)

Second Place \$750

Third Place \$500

Three "Honorable Mention" ribbons will also be awarded.

Awards will be announced and presented at approximately 6:00pm during the reception, Sunday, September 20, 2009, 5:30pm-7:00pm. Avery Research Center for African-American History and Culture, 125 Bull Street.

ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

- Artwork in the following categories may be submitted: oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, printmaking, drawing, graphics, fiber, sculpture, metals, ceramics, photography, basketry and mixed media.
- Submitted work must have been produced within the last two years and not previously submitted or exhibited at any City Gallery, Piccolo Spoleto or MOJA Arts Festival Exhibition.
- Wall pieces must be framed and ready for hanging, complete with screw eyes and wire. Freestanding pieces must be ready for installation with any necessary hardware included.
- Accepted work will remain as placed and may not be removed before the close of the exhibition. All work will be considered FOR SALE unless otherwise specified. NO commission from sales will be taken, all transactions are the responsibility of the artist.
- All work accepted for the exhibition will be insured while on display.

CALENDAR FOR THE EXHIBIT

August 20

CDs, entry fee, application and self addressed stamped envelope must be received by 5:00pm.

August 28

On or about this date notification will be sent to artists along with specific delivery and shipping instructions.

September 17 (approximately)

Accepted work must be delivered to the Avery Research Center for African-American History and Culture, 125 Bull Street, in accordance with the instructions outlined by the City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs.

September 20

Reception and Awards Presentation

November 2 (approximately)

Artists must pick-up work or make arrangements for return or delivery of work. The City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs will not be held responsible for work not picked-up.

PARTICIPATION RULES

- All artists must be Florida, Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina residents.
- Submit a maximum of 5 images on a JPEG formatted CD.
- For digital images on CDs, list your last name and the image number as the file name.
- Indicate price to be listed in the exhibition catalogue.
- Submitted CDs must represent work available for the September 20 - October 30 exhibition. Artwork sold during the exhibition must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit.
- Submit a \$25 non-refundable entry fee with completed entry form.
- Make cashier's checks or money orders (only) payable to City of Charleston.
- Send a self-addressed stamped (correct size) envelope with proper postage for return of CDs and notification.
